Travelling by public transport is also a very good option. The city has a reliable urban public transport service, complemented by interurban transport and taxi services.

The urban bus consists of 8 lines and 102 stops, distributed throughout the different neighbourhoods of the city.

Manresa is also the arrival city of the Ignatian Way, a route that starts from the Basque Country and ends in Catalonia. You can discover this route in different stages either on foot or by bike. getting registered

If you are planning on living in Manresa for more than six months, even if it is in rented accommodation, you can register as a resident (registration in the Resident Register) in order to obtain citizen rights, such as medical care.

This procedure is free and must be done in person with a prior appointment at the Manresa City Council's Citizen Service Office (Plaça Major, 1).

You can make an appointment by phoning (+34) 93 878 23 01 (this is recommended because you will be given personalised information about the documentation you need to provide), **or by WhatsApp at the number (+34) 644 069 801** (start the conversation by sending "hola") **or by following the link: manresa.cat/citaprevia**
